“Pre-Christian war and peace in Fiji: Disturbing dominant perceptions”

This paper explores pre-Christian Fijian history for clues about how indigenous Fijians did politics in the distant past. It proposes that contrary to popular perceptions, they used a myriad of means to reach political settlements without necessarily resorting to violence.
